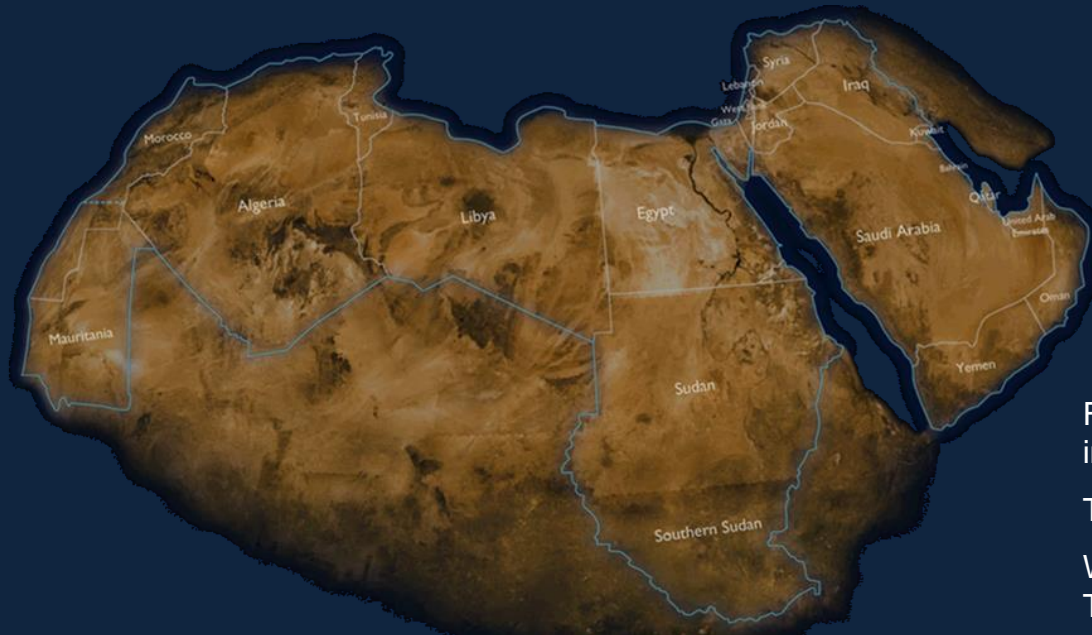

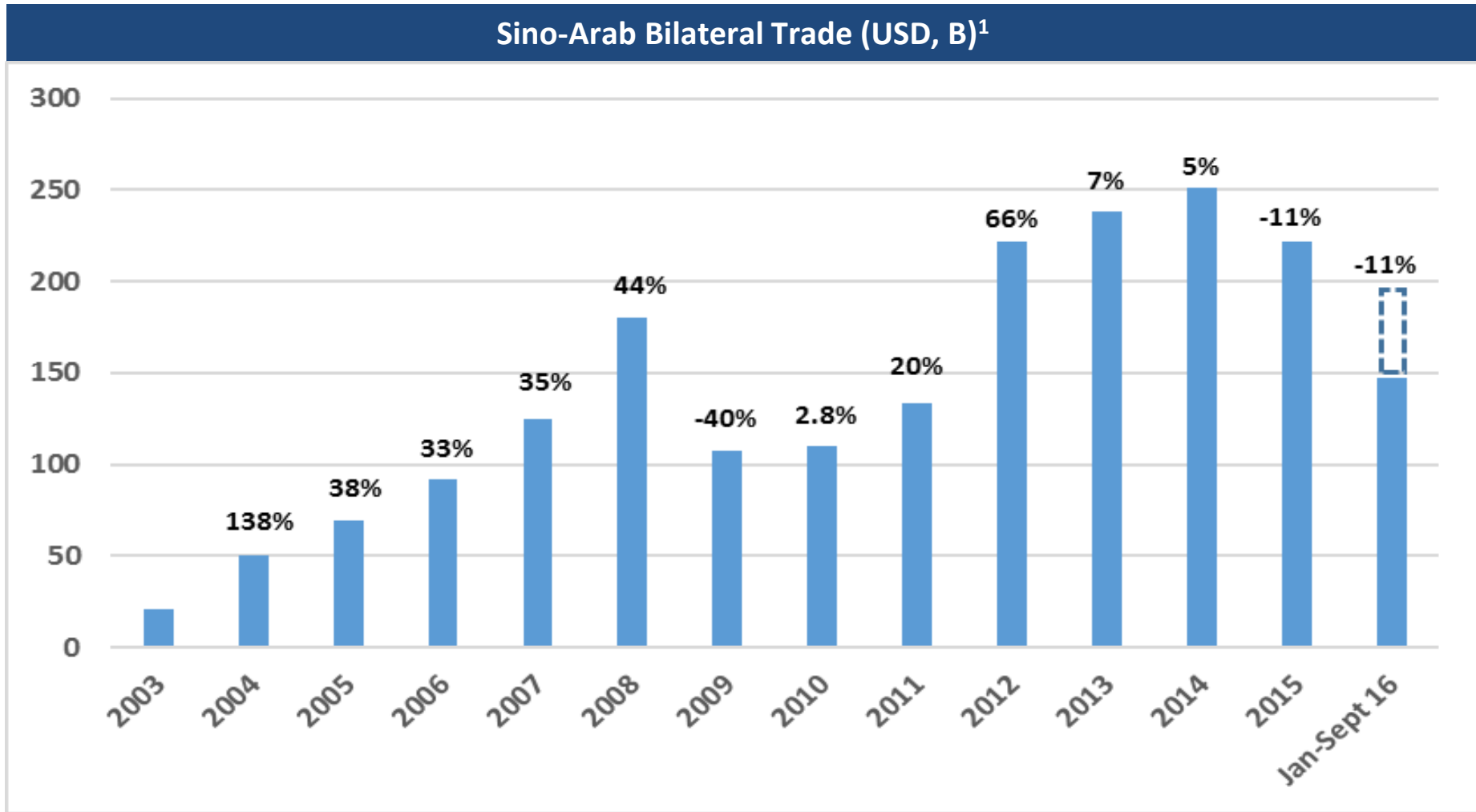
UAE, MENA & China: Centre stage within “OBOR”

China One Belt One Road Map¹



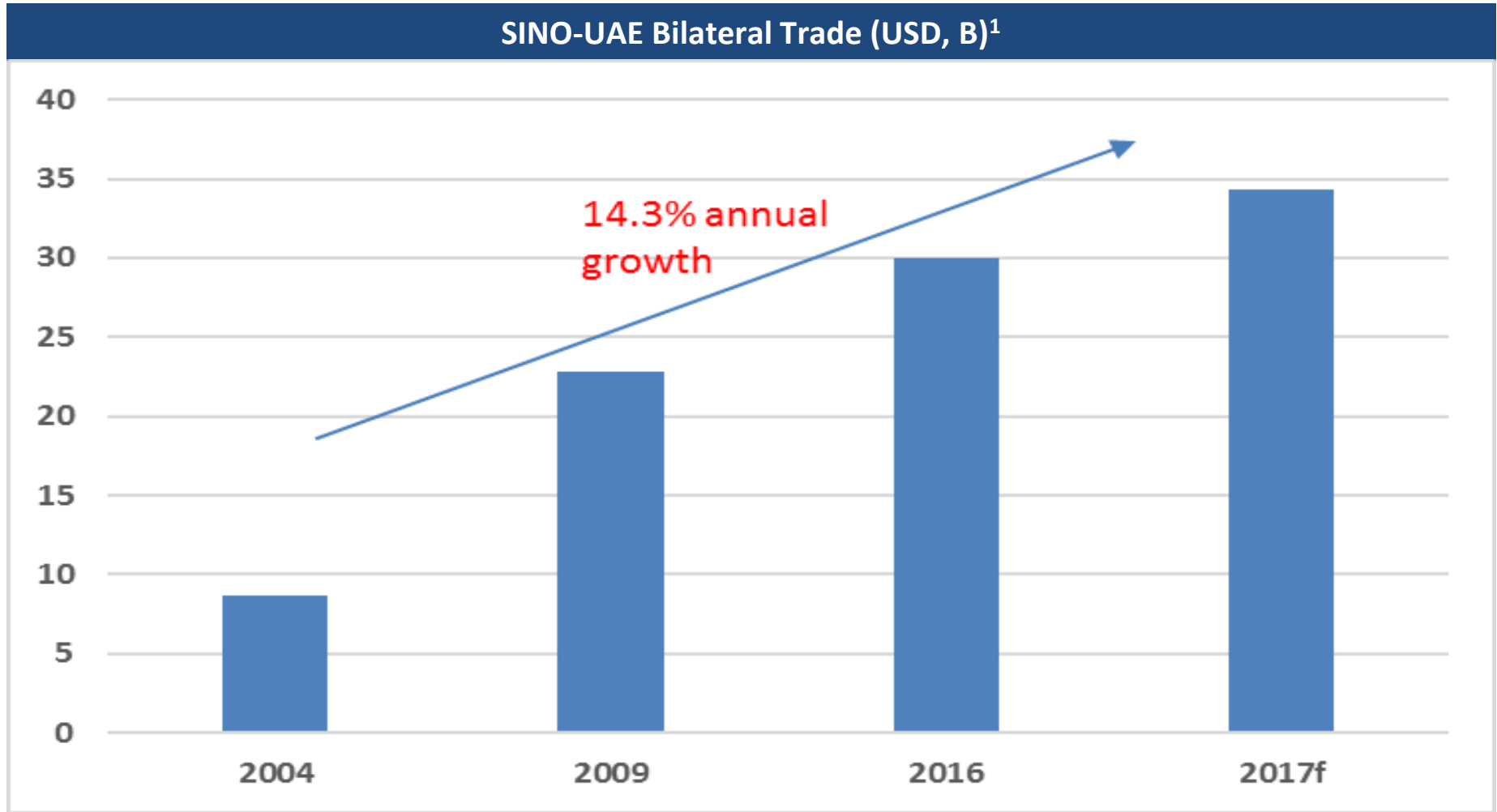

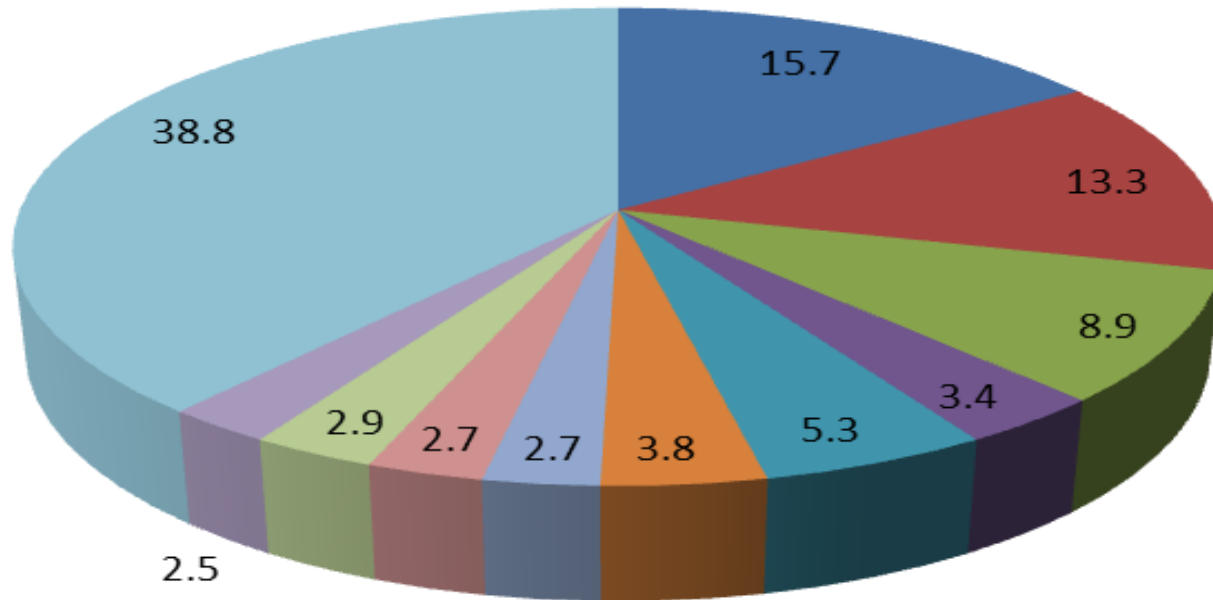
China-UAE Bilateral Trade: Up 3-fold since 2004

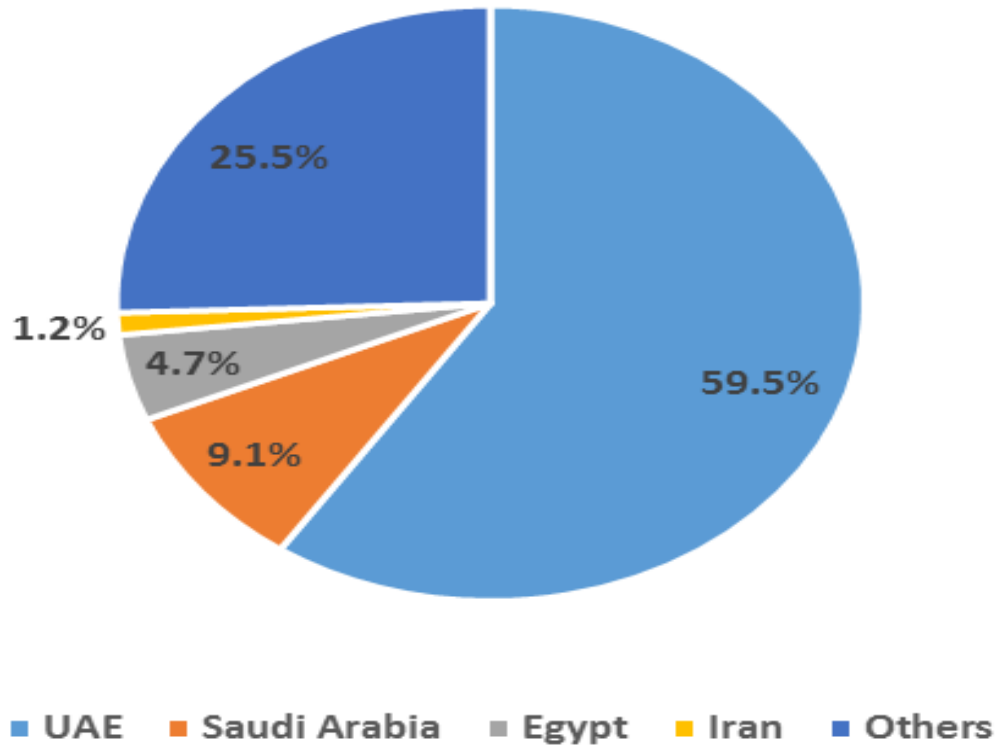

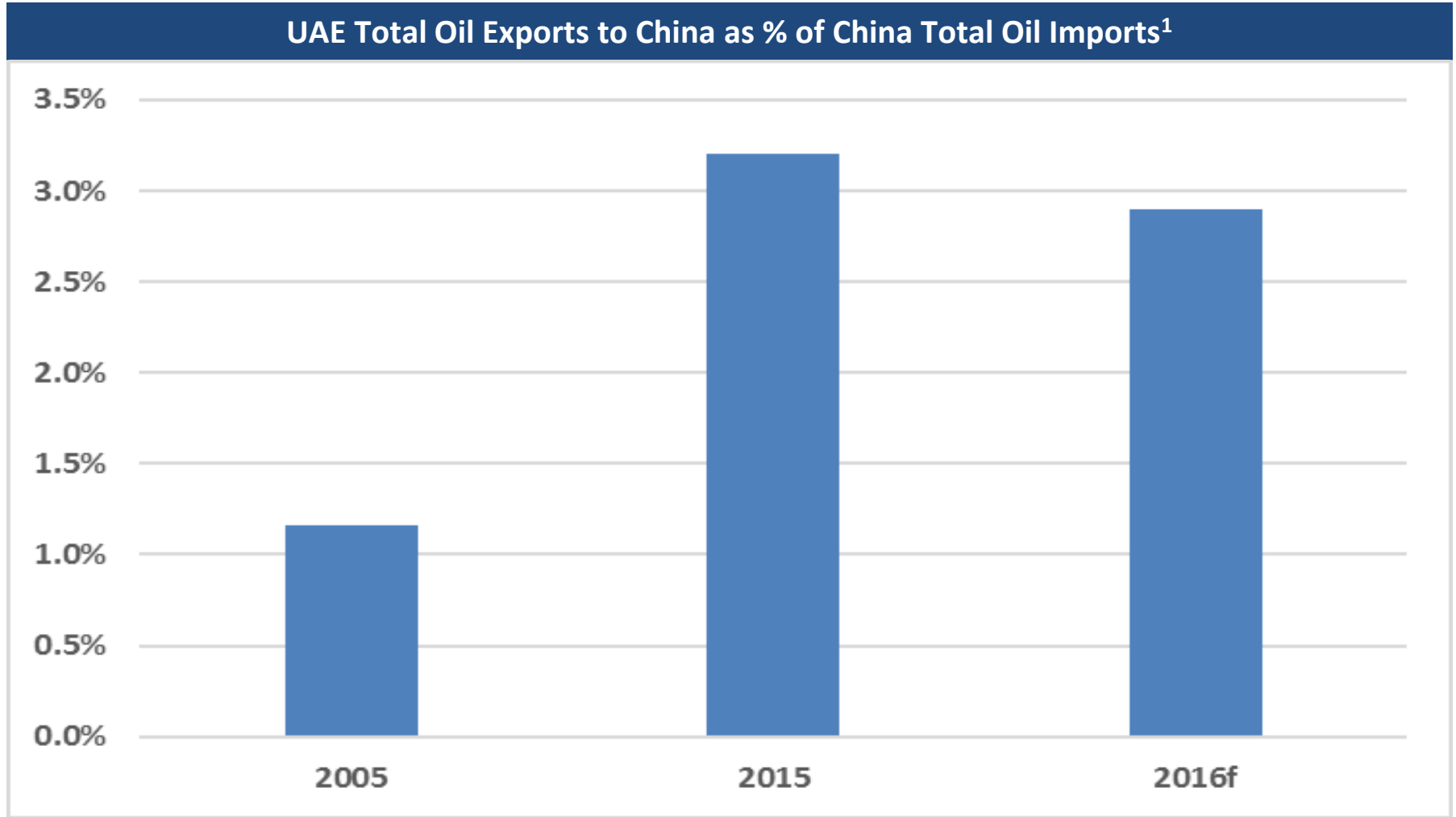
UAE leads MENA trade with Hong Kong

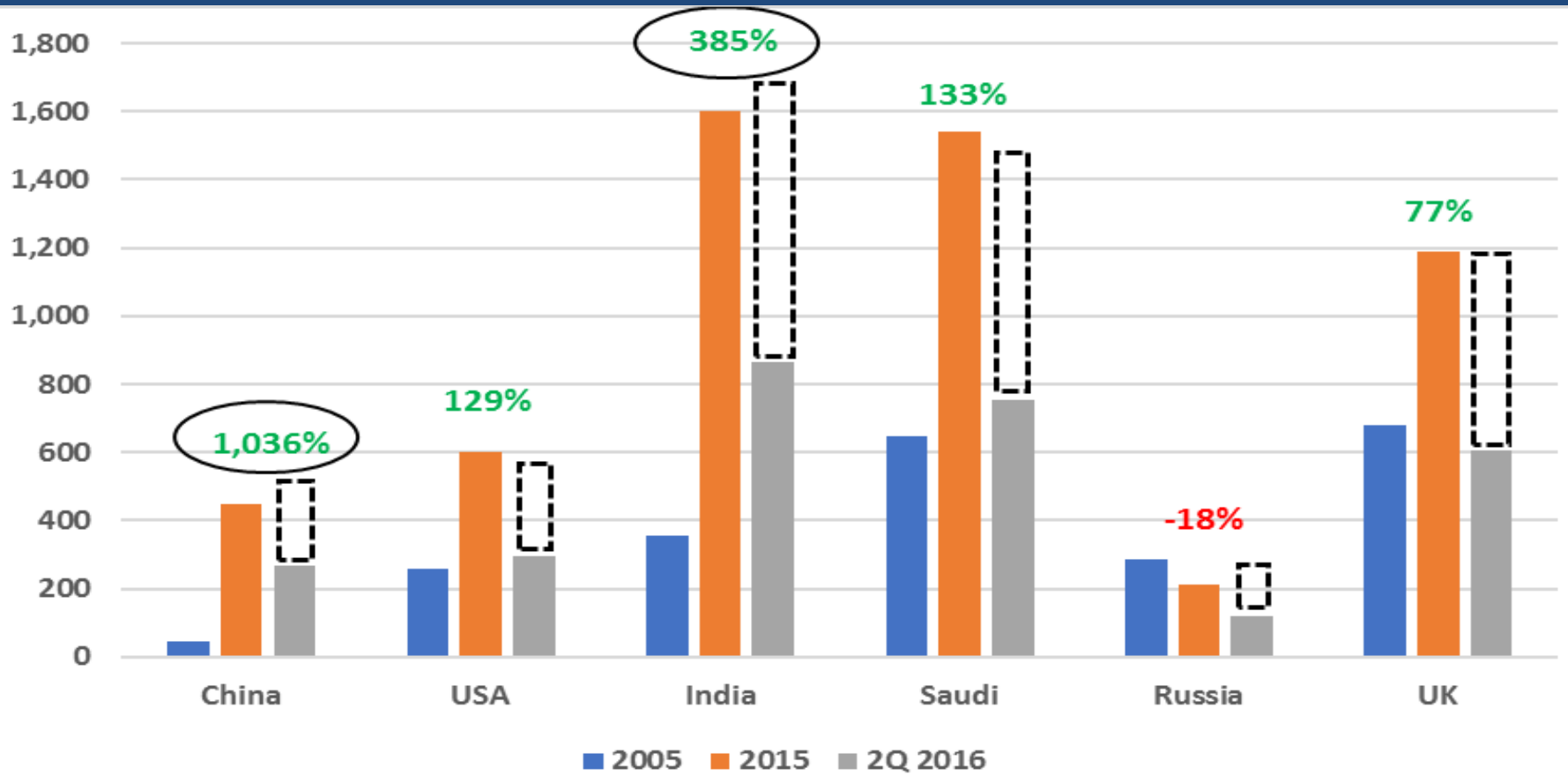
China: 87% avg. annual growth in UAE oil exports
